Topic: Recap of Texas 87th Legislative Session with Sen Springer & Rep Smith

We have invited Texas **Senator Drew Springer** and **Representative Reggie Smith** to tell us what took place during the 140 days they were in Austin tending to the affairs of “We Texans.” Some described this 87th session as a failure since they only passed one of the Top 8 + 1 Legislative Priorities voted on by the delegates at the State Convention or voted on at a Texoma Patriots meeting. But what was accomplished?



Our two elected officials are coming to inform us about what new laws passed, which ones never made it for a vote and why, and what's on the Governor's desk awaiting signature. Republican Party of Texas (RPT) priorities this session were Election Integrity, Religious Freedom, Children and Gender Modification, Abolition of Abortion, Constitutional Carry, Monument Protection, School Choice for All, and Ban Taxpayer-Funded Lobbying.
